# VILLA VANOWEN

14142 Vanowen Street, Los Angeles, CA 91405



Villa Vanowen is a 64-unit, affordable and supportive housing development in the Van Nuys neighborhood that will provide affordable studio apartment homes and on-site supportive services by The People Concern.

Villa Vanowen will be developed as a four-story, 39,000-square-foot building. The first floor is comprised of a visitor's lobby, community room with kitchen, bicycle storage and a bicycle maintenance area, resident service coordination/case management, and administrative offices. There will also be two second-floor roof decks consisting of 1,140 square feet.

Construction commenced in Summer 2023 with completion expected in Spring 2025.
